### Hong Kong Tourism Board to Receive HK\$1.35 Billion to Promote Travel Recovery, Host Handover Anniversary Events

The Hong Kong Tourism Board will receive a total budget of HK\$1.35 billion this year, to promote cross-border travel and celebrate the 25th anniversary of the city's handover to Mainland China. Over half of the board's total financial resources this year would be used to promote tourism. The executive director Dane Cheng said the tourism body had predicted significant growth in the number of arrivals during the second half of 2022, potentially reaching 9.6 million inbound travelers. ### Government to Launch Job Aid Scheme

The Government re-introduced the Employment Support Scheme (ESS) to lay the foundation for speedy economic recovery. It is estimated that the 2022 ESS will benefit around 160,000 employers, 1.6 million employees and 140,000 self-employed people. Employers will have to use all subsidies on employees. ### HKECIC Launches “Export Credit Guarantee Programme” to Facilitate Hong Kong Exporters in Obtaining Trade Finance

The Hong Kong Export Credit Insurance Corporation (HKECIC) announced on 29 March 2022 the launch of the “Export Credit Guarantee Programme” (“the Programme”) on a pilot basis for 12 months. Under the Programme, HKECIC will guarantee up to 70 percent of the export financing of the policyholders at a maximum guarantee limit of HK\$50 million. The lending institutions will, after credit assessment of the policyholder, apply to HKECIC for a guarantee limit for the loan amount to be advanced. [More details...](#)

## Payment Trends – Digital Wallets will Surpass Credit Cards as the leading e-Com Payment method by 2025

The Global Payments Report by Worldpay from FIS, covering the payments landscape by region and in 40 select markets, released the latest findings. In Hong Kong, accounting for 42.8 percent of e-Com transaction value in 2021, credit cards are projected to decline through 2025, yielding share primarily to digital wallets while e-Com projected growth will reach US\$31bn in 2025.
